A fascinating journey through the centuries: from the evocative silence of underground oil mills to the grandeur of the castle, up to the voices of poets who made this land immortal.

The itinerary at a glance:

1. The roots

Meeting point at the Underground Oil Mill. A journey into the “belly of the earth” to discover the origins of the village and the ancient olive oil culture.

2. Faith and art

Visit to the Church of the Immaculate Conception and the Church of San Leucio, featuring the 18th-century polychrome marble High Altar and the precious painting by Catalano.

3. The fortifications

Storytelling of the ancient walls and Turkish raids in Largo Santa Lucia, with a view of the charming “porticeddha”.

4. Baronial power

Entrance into Piazza Castello to admire Palazzo Trianni, the Ancient Monastery, and the majestic Baronial Castle.

5. White and poetry

Conclusion in the scenic Piazza Caduti, among the characteristic white houses, with a reading dedicated to poets Vittorio Bodini, Salvatore Toma, and Antonio Verri.
